This May the Artists Open Houses festival is bigger and better than ever – with 200 artists' homes and studios opening their doors to exhibit work from over 1,000 artists and makers in Brighton, Hove and beyond. Plan your visit around the 13 individual trails listed in the AOH brochure, or take your pick from the wealth on offer. The Open Houses stretch from Portslade to Kemptown and out to Rottingdean, Newhaven and the South Downs village of Ditchling.

Visiting Open Houses offers the chance meet the artists and to buy work directly from them. The hugely diverse range of artwork on show includes original paintings, prints, graffiti arts, ceramics and textiles, as well as photography, sculpture, crafts, jewellery and many other media.

The Artists Open Houses is an inclusive open-to-all event, welcoming participation from all areas of the community, including community groups, those otherwise excluded from the art world mainstream, school and college student artists.

Entry to the houses is free and many Open Houses also offer the opportunity to get involved, providing workshops and events for both adults and children. With homemade tea and cake on offer too, the Artists Open Houses are a very special weekend treat.

Opening times

Most Open Houses are open May weekends from 11.00-17.00, but opening times may vary from venue, so it is best to check individual brochure listings. Some venues are also open on weekdays and many open for both May Bank Holiday Mondays.

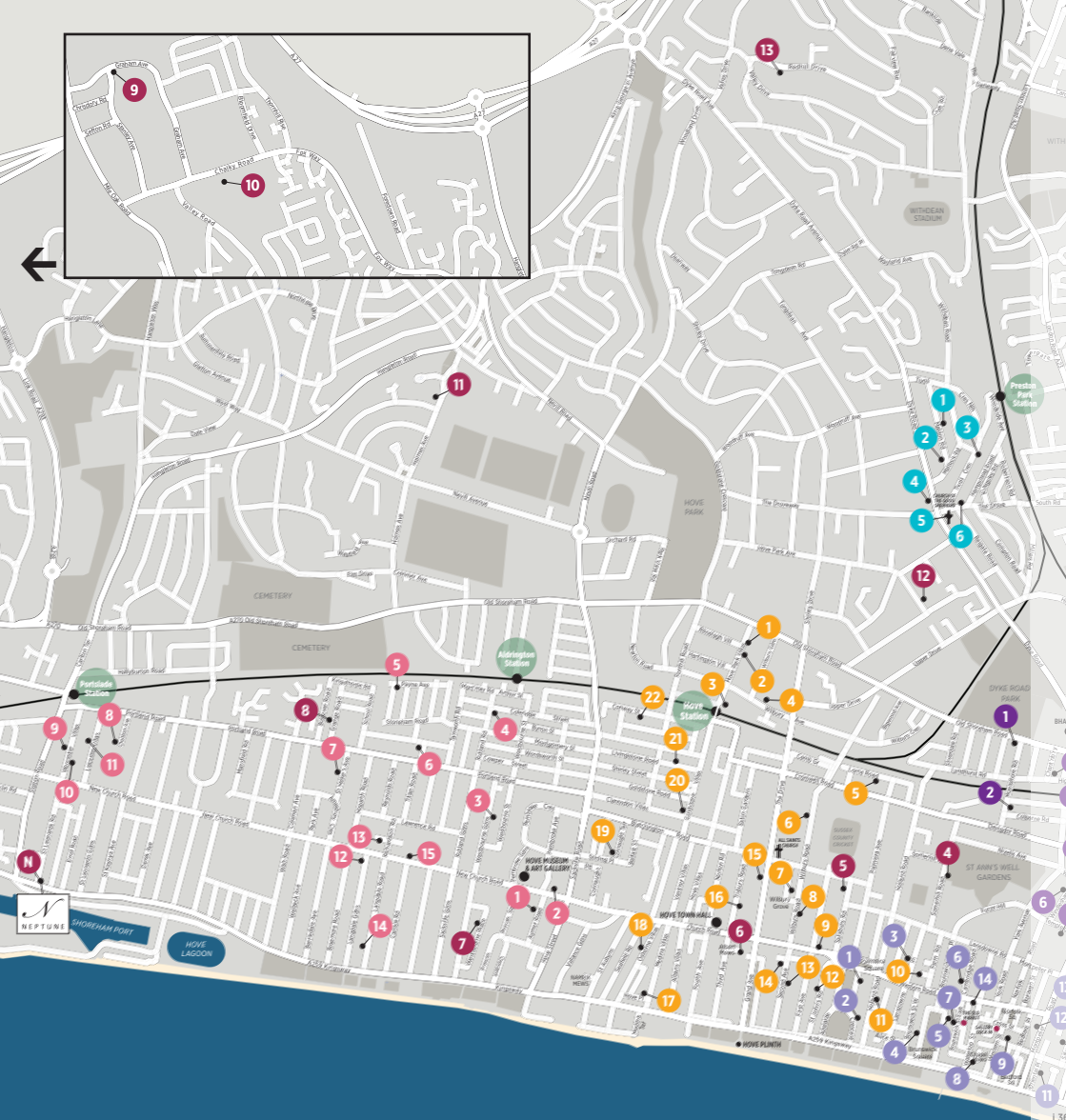

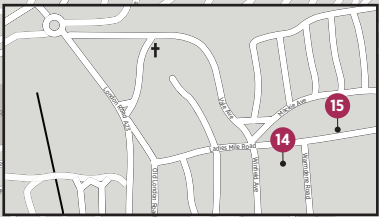

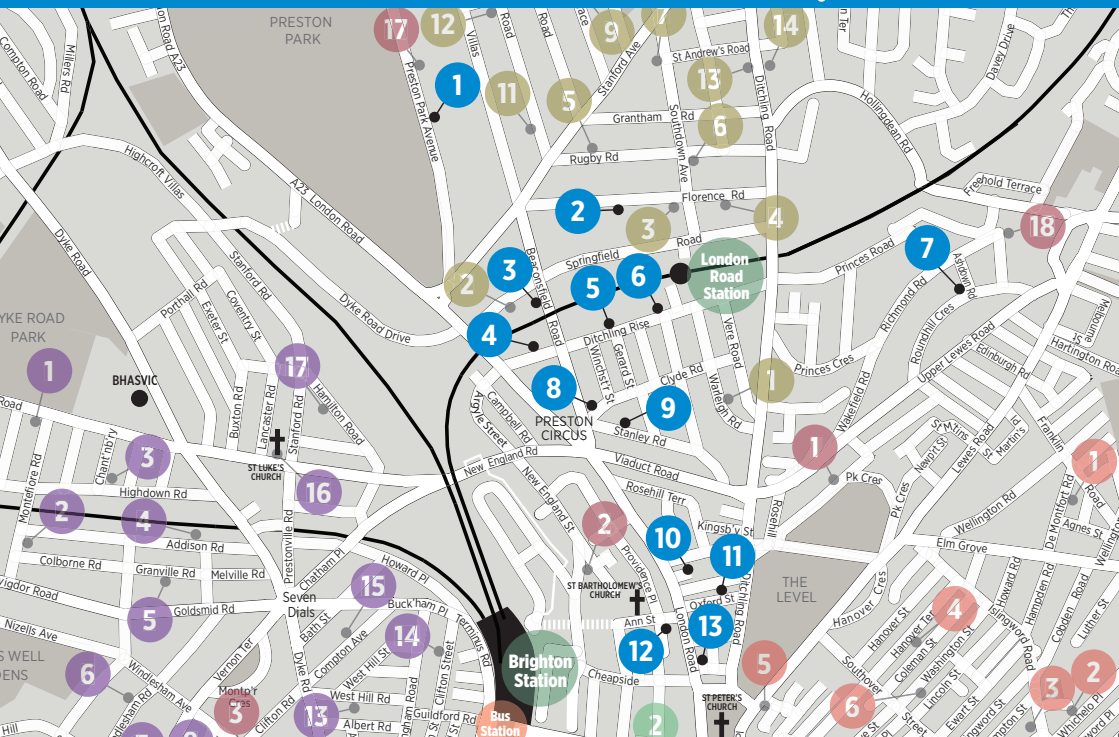
Once registered you can pay using touch-tone or text, following the instructions on the meter. You do not need a smart phone for these methods.

Starting in the early 1990s, Beyond the Level trail successfully evolved into one of the main Open House attractions, and in this 24th year numbers 13 houses, studios and a cafe. Beyond the Level showcases the work of an ever-growing community of practising artists and designers living and working in or around the vibrant, rejuvenated London Road area of Brighton. Situated north and west of The Level recreation space, and extending into the Roundhill conservation area, the trail offers visitors quality original arts and crafts, in informal and homely settings, at affordable prices.

Please note that while many houses and studios now have card payment facilities, some only accept cash or cheques. Where most venues are the artists' own homes, we may be unable to offer specialist access for disabled visitors, but will endeavour to give appropriate assistance where required. 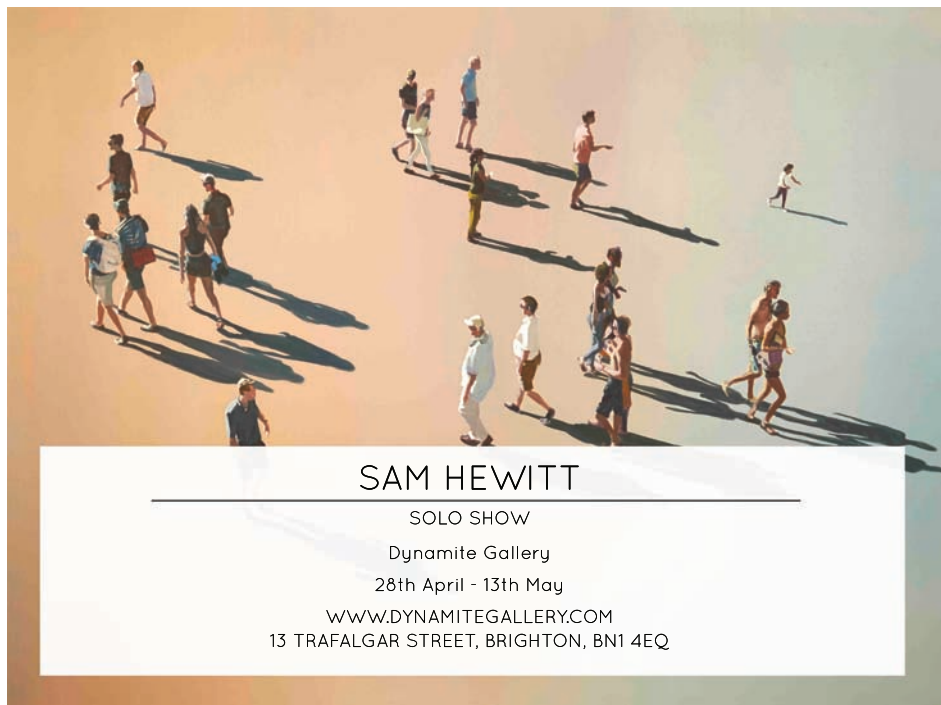
John Frederick Weaver

'Mystery at Tudor Close'

Once a hotel well known to the movie stars of the day, Tudor Close is one of Rottingdean's most intriguing architectural treasures. Created from derelict farm buildings, embellished with old oak ship timbers, to replicate the Tudor style and complete with decorative carvings and fictitious dates, the popular hotel ran from 1929 to 1952.

Amanda pays homage to this Mock Tudor folly, purported to be where 'Cluedo' was played in its original parlour game format of 'Murder at Tudor Close'. 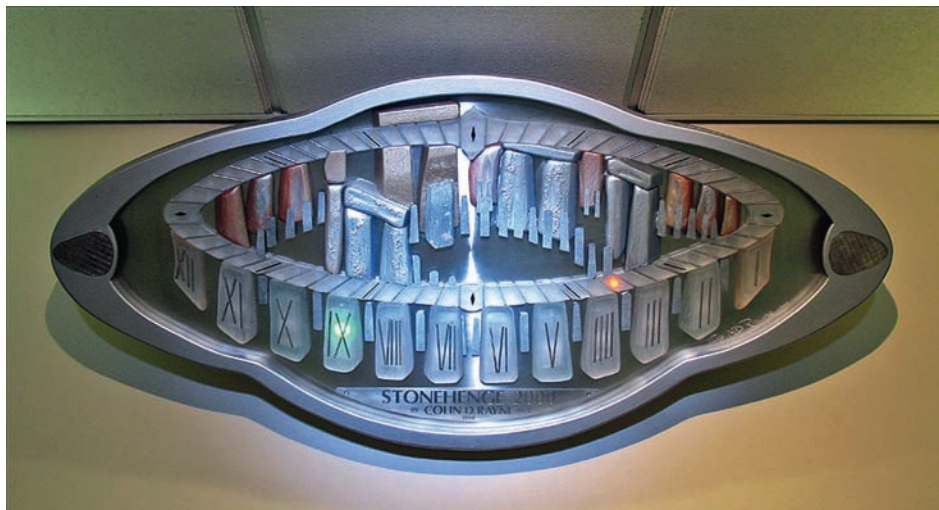

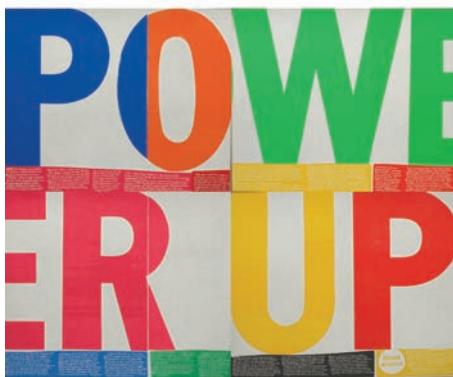

Over the last 30 years their complete precious metal design-to-make service, has delighted customers worldwide. This year's collection features hand cut Rough Diamonds, Emerald, Tanzanite, Lapis lazuli and Labradorite.

They also incorporate or redesign your existing jewellery in a process called 'A Precious Legacy'. Designer **Rebecca Smith** takes inspiration and materials from your jewellery collection to generate designs for new pieces. It ensures that your jewellery is enjoyed and worn whilst maintaining the sentimental connection to past pieces.

The jewellery pictured has been made with recommissioned antique diamonds in 18ct yellow gold. These antique diamonds are rare and unique, created by hand. The level of craftsmanship and skill required to create a beautiful diamond using only the most basic bruting techniques is astonishing. The connection that the diamond cutters had with their creations was much more labour intensive and personal than with modern laser cutting and each stone has its own character. Much more emphasis was put on the natural beauty of the diamond. These old cut diamonds have been remounted in 18ct yellow gold and their uneven shapes emphasized.

During the festival, take a tour of their workshops then follow it with a visit to Ditchling Museum of Art and Craft, which features the work and tools of Anton Pruden's grandfather, Dunstan, silversmith with the Guild of St Joseph and St Dominic.

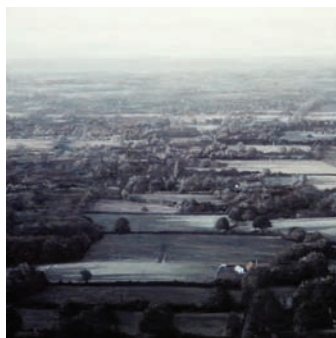

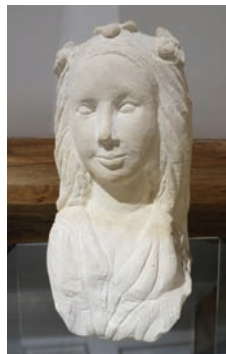

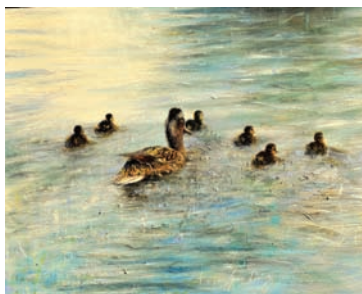

Pinelands is less than a 5 minute walk from Hassocks Railway Station and there is ample parking.

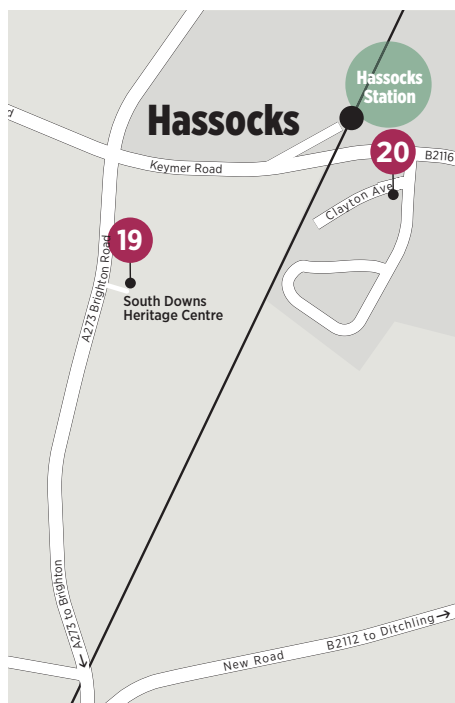
