Artists Open Houses

4-26 May 2019

This May sees over 1,500 artists and makers exhibiting their work in artists' homes and studios – providing a snapshot into the world of the city's artists. The Artists Open Houses offer festival-goers the chance to meet the artists and to view locally made, seriously good arts and crafts. The festival is also an inclusive, community event, embracing artists of all ages, at all stages of their careers, including recent graduates and school and college students. AOH welcomes artists from all areas of the community, especially those who may otherwise be excluded from the mainstream art world and who may have experienced periods of homelessness, are in recovery, have learning disabilities or mental health issues.

Visiting Open Houses offers the chance to chat to the artists and to buy work directly from them. The hugely diverse range of artwork on show includes paintings, prints, photography, sculpture, installation and performance, as well ceramics, textiles, jewellery and work in many other media.

Plan your visit around the 14 individual trails listed in the AOH brochure, or take your pick from the wealth of venues on offer. The Open Houses stretch from Portslade to Kempdown and out to Rottingdean, Newhaven and the South Downs village of Ditchling.

Entry to the houses is free and many Open Houses also offer the opportunity to get involved, providing workshops and events for both adults and children. With homemade tea and cake on offer too, the Artists Open Houses are a very special weekend treat.

Opening times

Most Open Houses are open May weekends from 11.00-17.00, but opening times may vary from venue, so it is best to check individual brochure listings. Some venues are also open on weekdays and many open for both the May Bank Holiday Mondays.

Hannah Forward @The Old Market

AOH cover artist, **Hannah Forward** is an artist and printmaker who works from her studio in Hove. She studied graphic design at Brighton University before becoming a full-time printmaker in 2018. Her work captures everyday events and artefacts of modern life, with particular attention to social events and personal pastimes. Using vivid colours and bold shapes she creates detailed, textured prints which have a sense of movement and strong graphic quality.

Last year Hannah's linocut print 'Cassette Tapes' (opposite) was selected for the 250th Royal Academy Summer Exhibition, curated by Grayson Perry. She was one of three artists chosen by the BBC to be filmed for their documentary about the RA Summer Show. After being selected, the entire edition of 'Cassette Tapes' sold out at the private view.

At The Old Market exhibition you can see this year's AOH Brighton & Hove brochure cover as an original linocut. There is a limited edition of 10 prints available (contact Hannah at the below email if you'd like to buy one).

Hannah will be also be showing her prints and paintings at 12 Scott Road (West Hove trail), which was nominated last year for best new Open House at the AOH Awards.

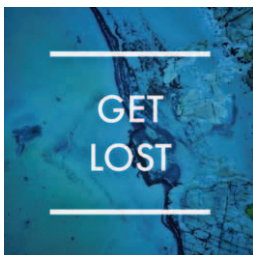
New Grounds: **FAKE/MAKE**



Sponsored by **The Old Market**, **FAKE/MAKE** is an exhibition of work by young and emerging artists curated by **Idil Bozkurt**

The origins of the aphorism 'fake it till you make it' can be traced to the 1970's and was used to describe a method where, by imitating confidence, capability and a hopeful outlook, a person can realise those qualities in their real life. 'Acting cheerful' was seen as a path to cheerfulness when spontaneous cheerfulness had been lost. Many disciplines, from psychology to self-care culture, consider such a mindset to be valuable in enabling an actual change in a person's behavior.

The New Grounds programme takes this phrase as a start point, exploring subjects of 'making' and 'faking' through speculation and self-reflection using various art forms. Why do we fake it? What happens to the intention of 'making' in the act of 'faking'? Does the by-product lose face value or the original purpose of the creation? Faking can be seen as being a fabricator or a charlatan; but can it also be a role-play, disguising, transforming and perhaps enabling the artist's creative act. When faking precedes making, how does this affect the artistic process? New Grounds artists will be considering 'faking/ making' as a reflective relationship, disclosing personal experiences within the artists' practices via sound performances, multimedia installations and workshops.

Although Brighton & Hove City Council has reduced the number of on street cash pay and display machines, there is usually one per street.

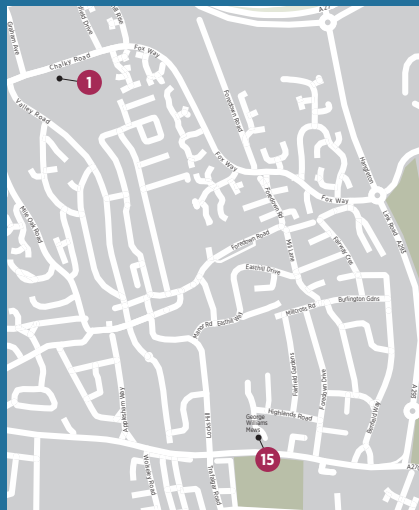

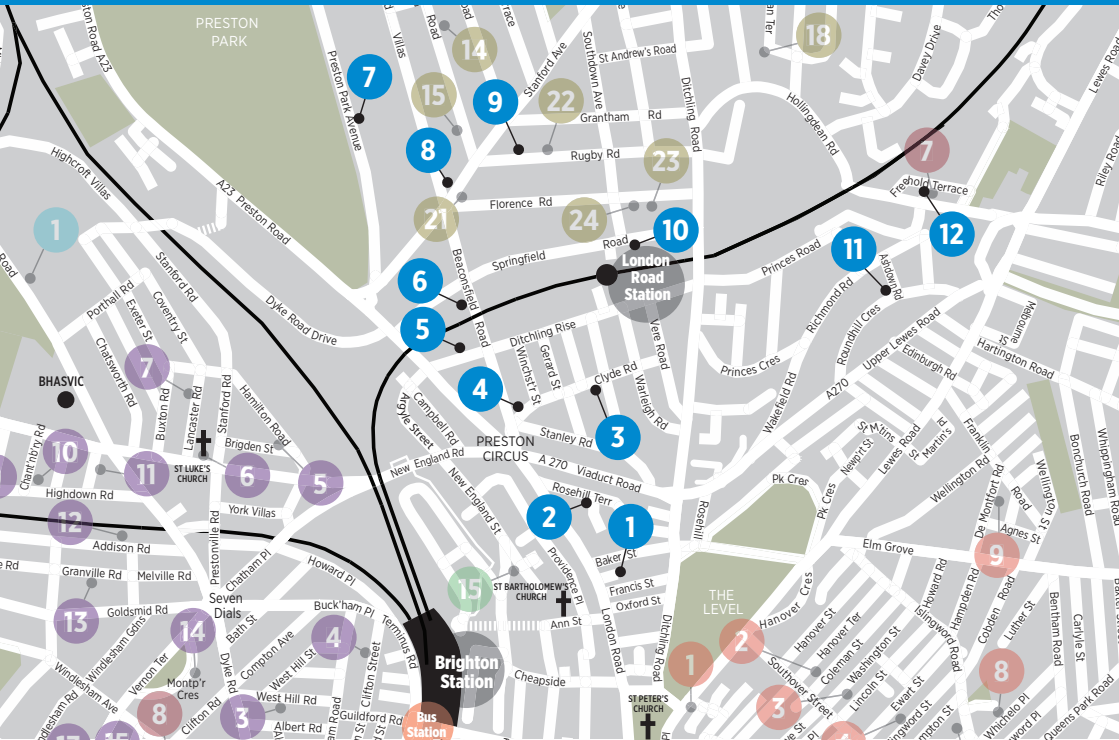

One of the oldest Open House trails in the festival it has successfully evolved into a diverse and eclectic community of 12 venues, including houses, studios, a pottery and a café. Beyond the Level showcases the work of practising artists, designers and makers living and working in or around the vibrant, rejuvenated London Road area of Brighton. Situated North and West of The Level recreation space, it extends to meet the Fiveways trail, moves up into the Roundhill conservation area, and drops down to a working pottery situated near Lewes Road Sainsburys. The trail offers visitors quality original arts and crafts, in informal and homely settings, at affordable prices.

Please note that while many houses and studios now have card payment facilities, some only accept cash or cheques. Where most venues are the artists' own homes, we may be unable to offer specialist access for disabled visitors, but will endeavour to offer appropriate assistance where required. 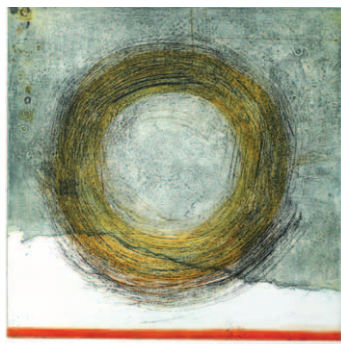

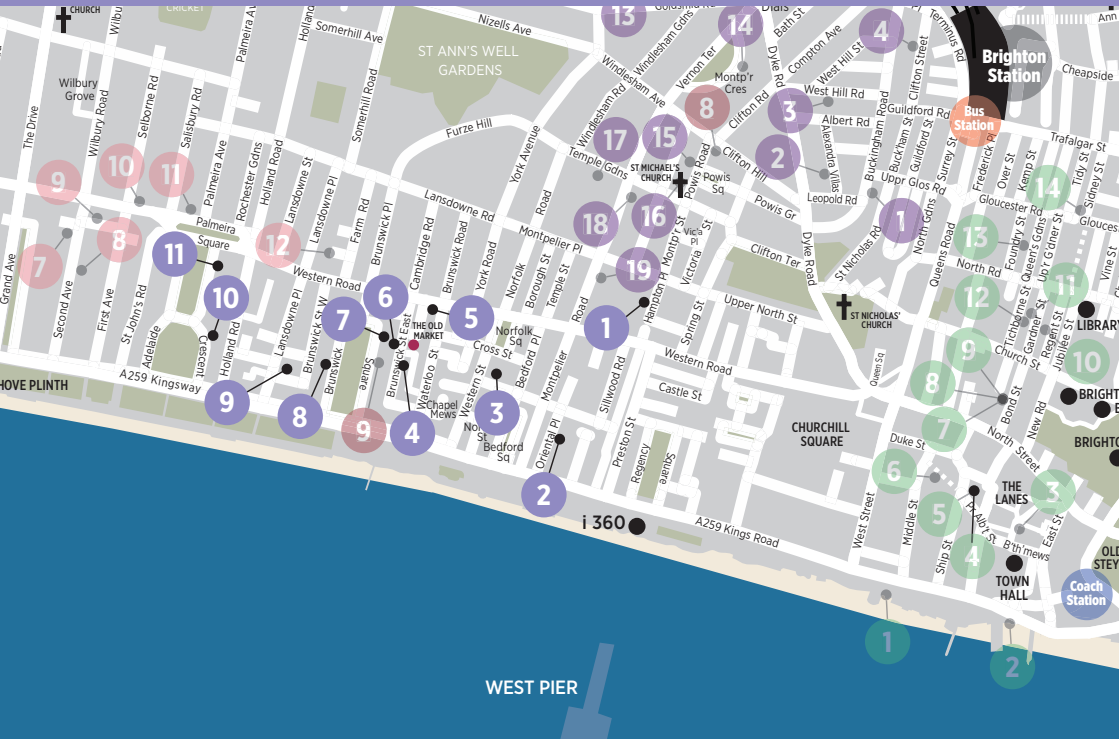

Brunswick Town



Brunswick Town Trail is on the border of Brighton and Hove by the seaside. The trail showcases high quality art, design and craft in a diverse range of places: houses, studios, workshops, a church, and a hotel. They are all easily accessible on foot. Make a day of it to meet the artists and makers, explore the historically and architecturally fascinating Brunswick Town Conservation Area, visit the seafront for a blast of fresh sea air and a flight on the i360. As a distraction from the trail there are a number of lovely pubs and cool cafes.

Travel information

Bus Catch any bus running towards Western Road and you will quickly find yourself in the heart the trail. (1, 1A, 2, 2A, 5, 5A, 5B, 6, 24, 25, 46, 49, 49A, 81).

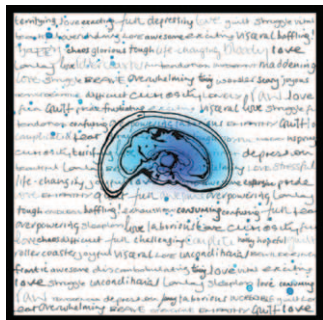

Recently opened and a newcomer for the Artists Open Houses 2019, le Roy Art Gallery is situated in a three storey 1780's fisherman's cottage. The building, restored back to its former glory, is an ideal setting for **Sara le Roy's** darkly humorous fairy tale painting series 3D Tales.

Old school red/blue 3D glasses need to be worn to see the effect which allows visitors to explore through narrow corridors and stairs at their own pace, to interact with paintings in a whole new way.

le Roy portrays fantasy characters with a twist, Disney but not as we know it. Snow White, Sleeping Beauty and Tinkerbell find themselves in the disenchanted here and now, wandering through mental wards, hospitals and crime scenes. Her work can be understood as a gothic, yet modern, psychedelic revision of traditional fairy tales. Gothic pop art plays with love, sexuality, religion and myths. The dwarves use heroin while Ariel walks the streets. The 3D glasses augment this effect; we literally go through the looking glass!

Also on display is le Roy's new 2D series, Know-Globes. Small-scale intricate oil paintings on aluminium, exploring otherworldly dreams and galaxy species in the 4th dimension, trapped and captured for eternity. As well as original paintings, there are hand-painted prints available on Foamex & Hahnemühle paper.

Sara le Roy is a Dutch artist living and working in Brighton. She has exhibited worldwide, including Aeroplastics Contemporary in Brussels and State-Of-The-Art Gallery in Hong Kong. Nationally, including the Threadneedle Prize & Royal Society of Portrait Painters at the prestigious Mall Galleries, London. Her work is held in private and corporate collections across the world.

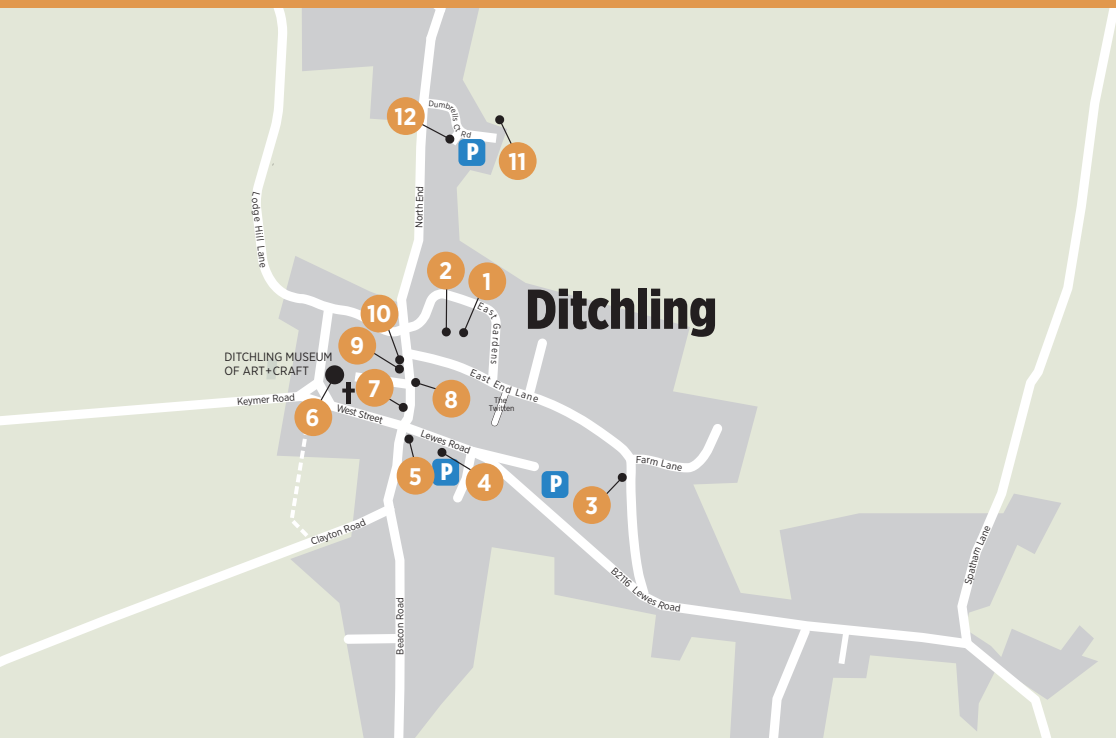
Ralph Levy Maker

The 2019 Art in Ditchling Trail is dedicated to the memory of Ralph Levy, creator of The Handmade House, who sadly died earlier this year. Originally from Napier, New Zealand, Ralph set up his home and studio at Beard's Place Farm in Ditchling in 2001. Aptly named The Handmade House, it soon became a hub for artists and craftspeople, and a favourite and renowned destination in the Artists Open Houses trail, winning Best Open House in 2007.

The Handmade House was a unique venue on the Ditchling Trail, and provided numerous artists and craftspeople with an opportunity to showcase their work both in and around the house. Ralph was a maker in his own right and was equally at home working with metal and ceramics. He also taught ceramics and provided a stimulating and encouraging environment for people to learn this craft.

A self-taught ceramist, Ralph experimented with many materials and techniques including forging steel, casting concrete and ceramics. He worked across the craft, design and art disciplines to create an extensive legacy of truly individual works. Inspired by Charleston Farmhouse, one of Ralph's long running projects was to collaborate with painters. Ralph made the pots, and the painters, using coloured slips, painted onto the surface of the ceramics.

He will be missed by so many.

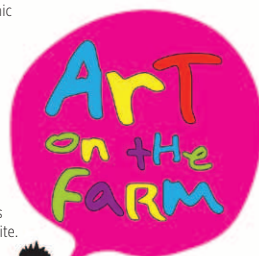

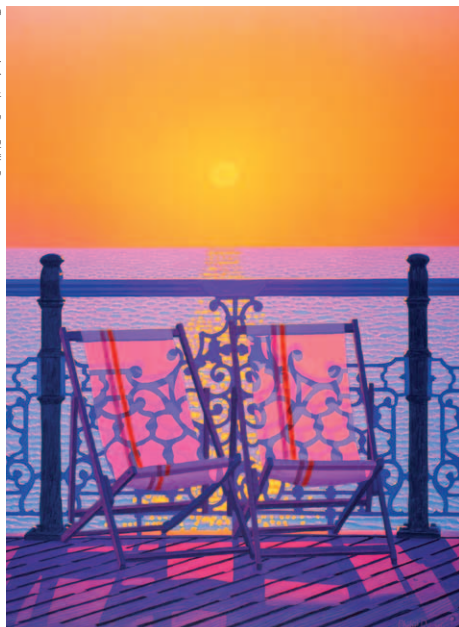

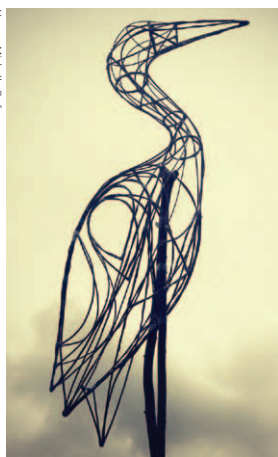
