Welcome to the Artists Open Houses (AOH); with a particularly festive mood in the air this May, AOH offers the opportunity to see work in nearly 200 artists' homes and studios. Several venues are also showing work in their gardens, providing a great day out viewing art indoors and out. Many Open Houses this year are open on the Coronation Bank Holiday Monday, May 8th, presenting an excellent addition or antidote to royal events.

Visiting artists in their homes and studios, viewing art in domestic settings, meeting the artists and makers, hearing about how the work is made and what motivates its makers, is always inspirational. Artists Open Houses embraces the entire community, encompassing all generations, from school students to residents of seniors' centres; from artists just starting out on their careers, to those with national reputations. Several venues include work of students, emerging artists, neurodiverse and learning-disabled artists. Some offer workshops and events where you can get hands-on and involved.

This year we're partnering with Sussex Nightstops, a community response to youth homelessness in Brighton and Hove that provides safe, welcoming places to stay for young people aged 16-25 who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Together we are launching an online auction of AOH artists' work; look out for available work in participating Open Houses, bid online and help support this brilliant organisation.

The Artists Open Houses has evolved to be not only the original, but the largest, most respected event of its kind, encompassing the entire city, reaching out to the surrounding villages. Many Open Houses also offer tea and cake in artists' gardens. Explore the city and travel out to the countryside, meeting the artists, buying new artworks for your home. The Artists Open Houses offer a great a day out full of inspiration and fun!



aisy Jordan, the Artists Open Houses May 2023 Brochure Cover Artist, is a visual artist, maker and puppeteer. Daisy was born and raised in Dartford, Kent, and is currently based in Brighton, where she studied Fine Art Painting at the University of Brighton from 2006-2009. She discovered her love for puppets after taking an evening class with artist Isobel Smith shortly after graduating, in which she created a life-sized orangutan complete with bonnet and dress. Since then, she has created and performed in her own puppet shows, often inspired by history and folklore. such as The Sorrowful Tale of Sleeping Sidney, based on the Brighton Chocolate Poisoner.

Daisy has regularly performed, since 2010, as puppeteer and singing waitress at Jane Bom-Bane's cafe in Brighton, which she feels really helped shape her as an artist and performer, and played a big part in directing her path. Storytelling is a very important part of her practice, whether that story be told through a painting, a puppet-show or her cardboard assemblage pieces. Her work tends to explore the boundary between human and 'other', with a particular focus on non-human primates.

For Daisy, our ever-changing relationship with, and perception of, our simian cousins encapsulates our complicated engagement with the natural world in a more general sense. Hovering on the seeming boundary between human and other, monkeys and apes have always provoked in us feelings of fascination and discomfort, and this, as a result. has led to their exploitation. Daisy enjoys playfully exploring this boundary by showing apes and monkeys in 'human' environments, such as the brochure cover piece, Olive Baboons on Rooftops.

The BTN Bikeshare scheme was relaunced with *Beryl* on 31 March 2023. Phase one of the scheme's relaunch sees around 75 e-bikes in operation. There will be 19 hubs along the seafront and between Brighton and Hove stations.

The number of e-bikes will increase 125 during this first phase. *Beryl* will bring more bikes and hubs into service in the coming months, with the total eventually reaching 780.














Brunswick Town Trail is on the border of Brighton and Hove by the seaside. The trail showcases high quality art, design and craft in a diverse range of places: from workshops and studios to Victorian terraced houses and Regency town houses. They are all easily accessible on foot. 
Jonny Olsson (1954 – 2023)
