Each weekend in May brings you the chance to visit artists and makers in over 190 venues across Brighton and Hove, out to the Downland villages of Ditchling, South Heighton and Hurstpierpoint, and along the coast from Portslade to Rottingdean and Ovingdean.

The Artists Open Houses festival provides a unique opportunity to meet artists in their homes and studios, hear about the making of the artwork and buy hand-produced work directly from the artists and makers. Many Open Houses also offer workshops for both adults and children to get involved, learn new skills and explore their creativity.

Highlights this year include AOH brochure cover artist, Kate Jenkins, whose extraordinary and beautiful crocheted food art has been exhibited everywhere from New York to Hong Kong. Several venues offer music, performance and screenings, alongside great sculpture and painting, exploring areas from the subconscious and the provocative, to views of the Sussex Coast and Downs. This year three venues celebrate 25 years of taking part in Artists Open Houses; Dion Salvador Lloyd on the Hove trail, and Frances Doherty and Art at 202, both in Fiveways.

Kate Jenkins is an artist and designer, celebrated for creating witty and colourful representations of everyday items in yarn and sequins. Best known for her knitted and crocheted food, Kate's playful interpretations include everything from loved-up sequined sardines to scowling hot cross buns. No matter where her fertile imagination takes her, humour and warmth are at the heart of all Kate's work, which is why her artworks feature in exhibitions and collections around the world

After a successful freelance career in fashion knitwear design, Kate began her journey as an artist after taking part in the Artist's Open House in 2007. Working from her Kemptown studio, Kate's creations are inspired by her environment and, particularly, the food we all love to eat. The piece she created for our front cover, the great British seaside's favourite, fish and chips, is a perfect example of her aesthetic.

Using the language of food, Kate's work spans different media and speaks to a global audience. Original artworks, illustrations for publications and mobile installations including a knitted and crocheted garden, a bakery and ice cream parlour, to name just a few examples, have appeared everywhere from Barcelona to Hong Kong, from New York to an award-winning 3-month solo show at the Rijswijk Museum in the Netherlands.

Kate regularly receives commissions and has worked with Chanel, Waitrose, the Royal Mail and fashion label, Anthropologie. Most recently, she was artist-in-residence on a Viking Cruise ship as it sailed around the Mediterranean. This year, Kate's famous knitted and crocheted fish counter has travelled to the glamorous surroundings of the Café de Paris in Monte Carlo after overwhelming response around the world following her Fishy Business show London 2024. Wherever her exquisite creations appear, Kate's motivation is the same, "Above all, I want my work to make people smile."
