Weekends 2nd-25th

Throughout May Brighton and Hove will be alive with festivities, including nearly 200 Open Houses spread across the city, along the coast and out to the village of Ditchling and beyond. Each weekend in May, artists will be opening their doors to welcome you inside, offering a unique opportunity to meet artists and makers in their homes, where you can hear about the making of the artwork, both the how and the why.

The beautiful 2026 AOH brochure cover illustration is by artist and printmaker Alej Ez; his artwork *Modern Bathers* weaves together personal ritual, local history, Modernist influence, and Brighton's built and maritime landscape into one layered composition. Don't miss the chance to visit Alej Ez's Brunswick home to see his print series *People and Places*, *Revelations of Love*, of which *Modern Bathers* is a part, or find his work in three other venues around the town.

In other Open Houses you can experience a pop-up dog tattoo parlour - tattooing dogs on humans - chatting ceramic vases, transient inflatable sculptures and artwork using living bacteria, DNA and technology to create intricate textile installations. Enjoy a sundowner in a Secret Garden, a creative cacophony in a Little Picture Palace, or enter a hidden tunnel to the Dream Fishing House. Many Open Houses also offer workshops for both adults and children to get involved, learn new skills and explore their creativity.

The Artists Open Houses festival welcomes all artists, from those just starting out on their careers to established artists and makers, including school and university students, neurodivergent artists, those with learning disabilities and mental health issues and residents of senior homes. Meeting the artists and makers and buying directly from them, means you are not only making unique purchases, but supporting both emerging and established creatives from throughout the city and region.

Visiting the Artists Open Houses presents a great way to explore Brighton and Hove beyond the usual tourist routes, whilst being creatively inspired - and maybe even sampling homemade cake and tea in artists' homes or gardens. A truly perfect day out! Take a look through our brochure and plan your May weekend festival tours.

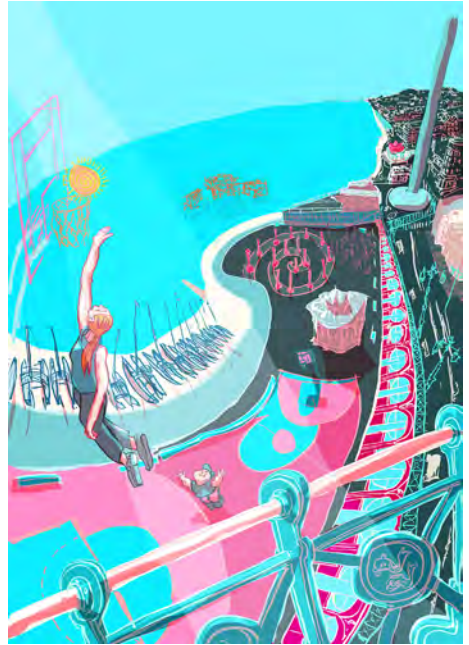
Alej Ez says: When my name was announced as the 2026 AOH Brochure Cover artist, it felt electric. Having participated in AOH for over twenty years, I understand the recognition and the potential that this award has as my design becomes the face of the AOH festival, seen by thousands of art lovers around town.

This year's brochure cover image, *Modern Bathers*, is rooted in personal experience, art history, and Brighton's layered identity. *Modern Bathers* weaves together personal ritual, local history, Modernist influence, and Brighton's built and maritime landscape into one layered composition.

Alej Ez says: I wanted to reference the tradition of bathing by one of Brighton's most famous historical characters, Martha Gunn, who is buried in St Nicholas churchyard. I am also a passionate swimmer - in the sea during the summer and year-round in the pool, training for competitions with my swimming club. And then what do you think of the technologies of swimsuits? This is without doubt a modern invention that takes us to this word in my title. *Modern Bathers*, which has taken me half a year to complete, sits comfortably within my series of prints, *People and Places*, *Revelations of Love*, which reflects on the Norfolk anchoress Julian of Norwich's book *Revelations of Divine Love*.

Throughout the festival, you can see *Modern Bathers* and other new prints in this series at Alej Ez's own Open House; his beautiful classic landscapes will be at The Old Market; and at The Flamingo House Alej Ez will be showing his new *Dragons* series straight out of the Royal Pavilion.

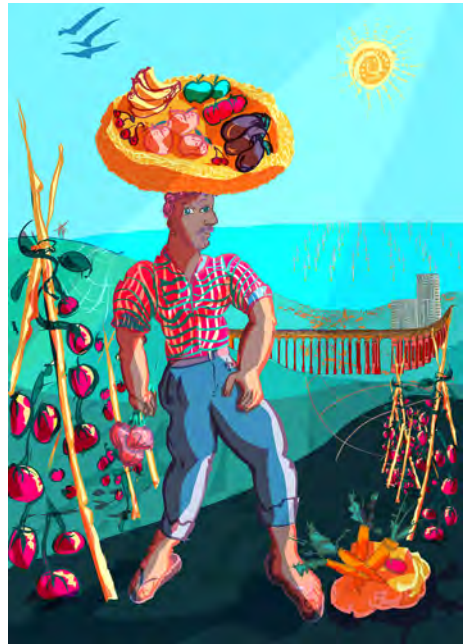

Travelling around the city to the Artists Open Houses couldn't be easier with the Brighton & Hove Buses app, plan your journey and buy tickets all in one place. <https://www.buses.co.uk/app>

For just £6 a day you can have unlimited travel on any Brighton & Hove Bus, including night buses. Tickets are available 24/7 and can be purchased to travel immediately or saved until later. Simply buy and activate your ticket, show the driver and away you go.

I feel things with a burning intensity and my canvas provides a container for these huge emotions. My work sings of tumbling hedgerows, tangled meadowlands and open moorlands. It is my intention to transport the viewer to a place that is literally saturated in joy. Where dreams are born.

Highest quality oil paints are applied in a multitude of layers. The alchemy of techniques result in a prismatic jewel-like composition of rich pigments that reveal the radiance of nature. I always paint outside and the elements, in a very direct way, dictate how and where the paint falls. 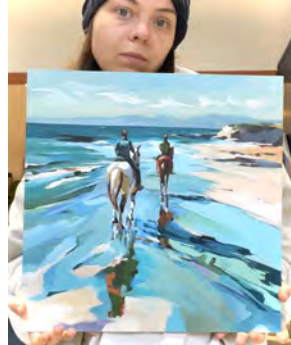

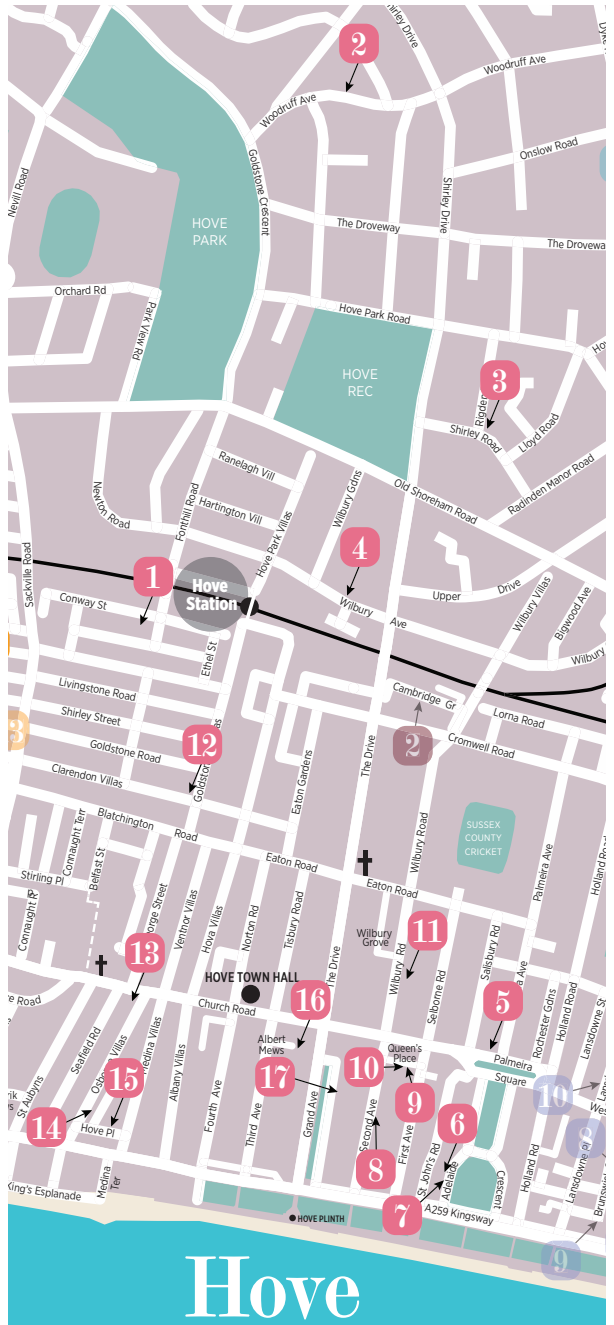

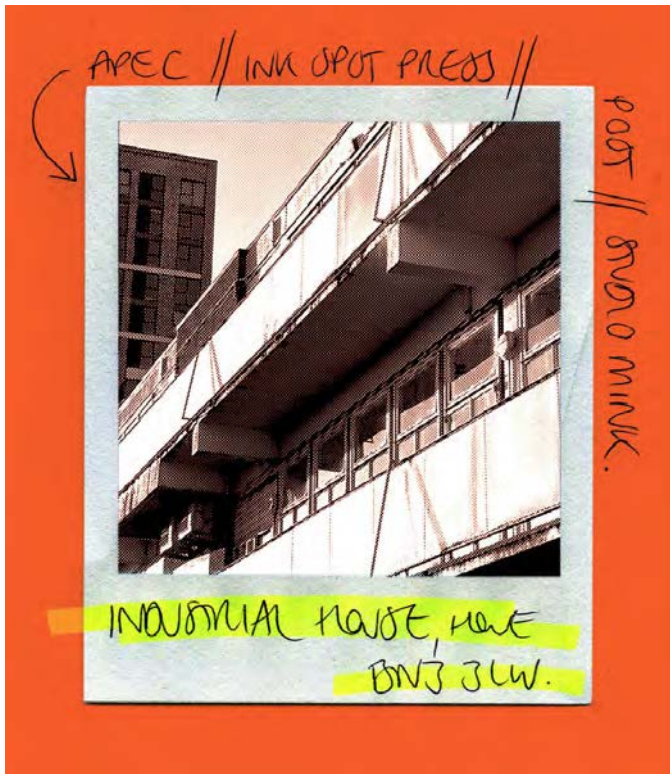

Industrial House, an unassuming 1970s industrial building minutes from Hove Station, is home to several artist collectives and creative spaces that look forward to welcoming you for the 2026 AOH.

The following studios will be open:

APEC [Art Producing Economic Community] is a not-for-profit studio group providing spaces for artists with diverse and wide ranging practices, encompassing painting, sculpture, performance, printmaking, photography and digital media. In its 22-year history APEC has been home to over 70 artists, curators and educators.

Inkspot is a professionally equipped Open Access printmaking studio providing facilities and expertise in screenprinting, letterpress, relief printing and photopolymer printmaking. They run evening and weekend courses for beginners and for more expert printmakers to brush up on their techniques. It is a friendly supportive place where you can meet like-minded people and exchange ideas and information.

POST is a newly established lens-based arts studio providing affordable artist spaces, photography studio, B&W darkroom, photobook library and gallery. Their year-round cultural programme includes exhibitions, artist talks, film screenings and workshops. For their first open studios, they will be running a series of exhibitions and ticketed performances (see POST website for specific schedule).

Studio Six is a shared creative space led by textile designer Rosanna Bishop (Studio MINK.), and home to fashion label Prier de Saône and instrument maker Eunju Lee. The open studios offer a chance to meet the makers, purchase screen-printed textiles, fashion samples and taster demos for the studio MINK. upcycling workshops.

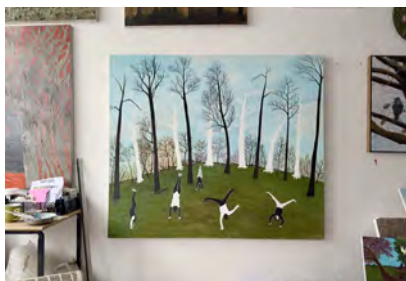

Walk

Bus

The Nature of Being is a vibrant and immersive collection of paintings inspired by the intricate beauty of insects and plant life, by sculptor and painter Romany Mark Bruce. The series was born from a fleeting, almost magical moment: a ladybird landing briefly on the nose of Romany's Irish Terrier. 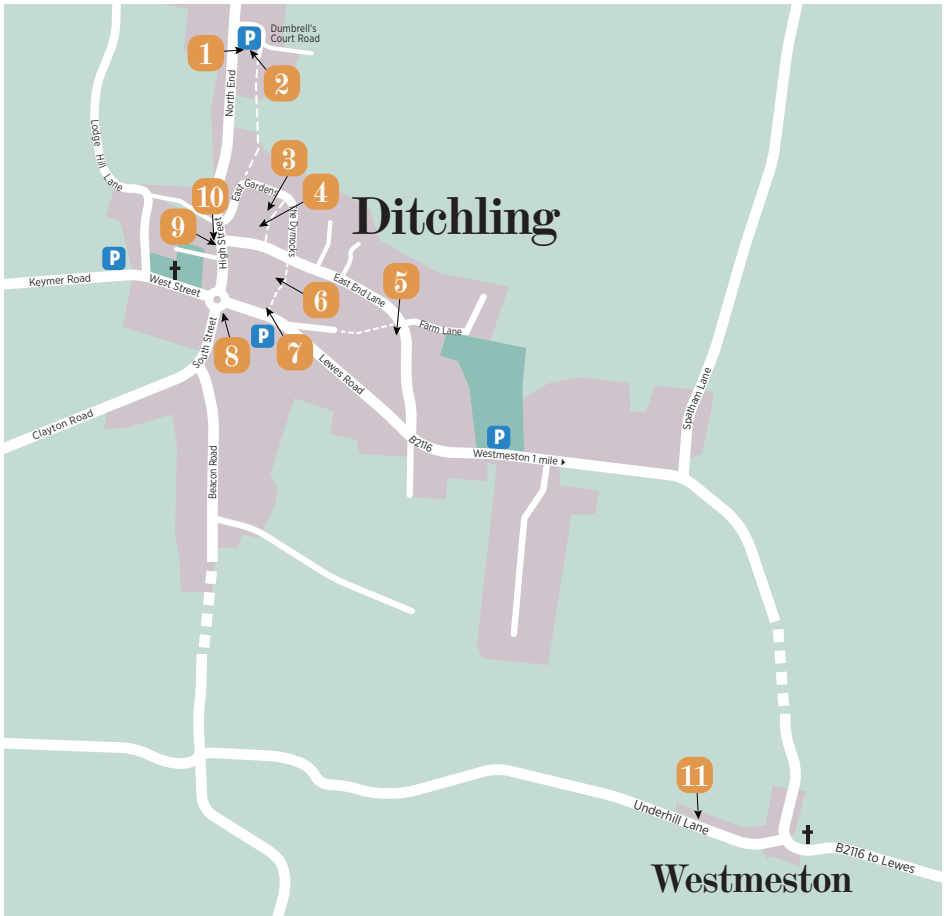

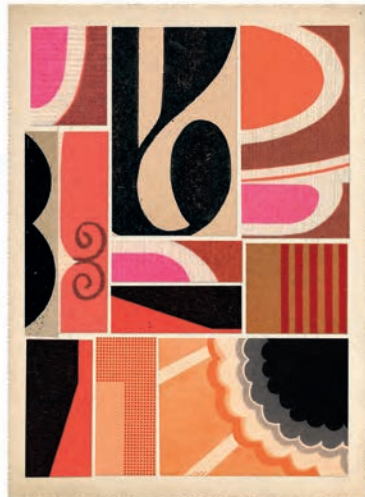

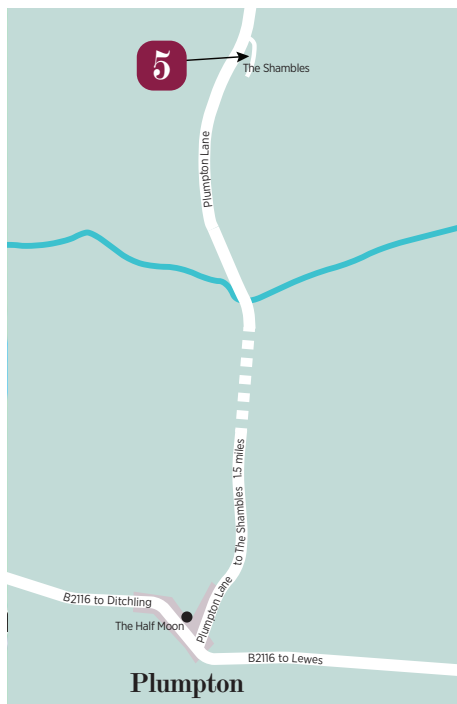
