Penelope Kenny, the Artists Open Houses May 2017 Brochure Cover Artist, is an Australian born artist who now lives and works in Brighton. Her work explores the relationship between humans and other animals, especially in connection to transhumanism, evolution, hybrids and biotechnology. Through her hybrid creatures she investigates the potential outcomes of humans trying to control evolution through genetic manipulation and scientific tampering with the species boundaries.

Since completing a BA in Printmaking at the University of Brighton she has exhibited widely, in the UK and internationally. She creates limited edition textiles, fine art screenprints, wallpapers and books using hand-made inks made from pure pigments and metallic glazes.





Once registered you can pay using touch tone or text, following the instructions on the meter. You do not need a smart phone for these methods.

Although Brighton & Hove City Council has reduced the number of on street cash pay and display machines, there is usually one per street.



Beyond the Level has become one of the main Open House attractions in the annual Brighton Festivals. Now in its 24th year and 12 houses and studios strong, Beyond the Level aims to showcase the work of an ever-growing community of practising artists and designers living and working in or around the vibrant rejuvenated London Road area of Brighton. Situated north and west of the Level recreation area, the Trail aims to provide visitors with quality original arts and crafts, in informal and homely settings, at affordable prices.

#### Travel information

**Walking** Beyond the Level is easily accessible by foot or bike - much of the trail is flat!

**Bus** The Preston Circus end is on the 5, 5A and 5B bus routes; Ditchling Road has the 26, 46 and 50; the Vogue gyratory end is served by the 23, 24, 25, 28, 29 and 49.





#### **Brunswick Town Trail**



**Brunswick Town Trail** can be found on the seaside boundary of Brighton and Hove. The trail showcases high quality art, design and craft in a diverse range of places this year: houses, studios, workshops, a synagogue, a church, a hotel and a health centre.

There are so many things to do in Brunswick Town that are all easily accessible on foot. Make a day of it to meet the artists and makers, explore the historically and architecturally fascinating Brunswick Town Conservation Area as well as visiting the seafront for a blast of fresh sea air and to feast your eyes on the new i360. As a distraction from the Trail there are a number of lovely local pubs and cool cafes offering delicious refreshments.

#### Travel information

Catch any **bus** running towards Western Road and you will quickly find yourself in the heart the trail. (1, 1A, 2, 2A, 5, 5A, 5B, 6, 24, 25, 46, 49, 49A, 81).

From Brighton **train** station, just hop on the number 6 bus towards Hove.

Pay by phone **parking** is available on most streets in the area.

Better still **walk**, **bike** or **skate** your way along the seafront to just beyond the West Pier.

Mackenzie Bell studied Fine Art at Exeter, Brighton and Central St. Martins. He taught Art in Los Angeles and Sydney and was Head of Art at St. Pauls College in Mid Sussex. In 1997 he left teaching to pursue a passion for painting and landscape garden design. He moved to Cornwall to create a five acre water garden, taking Monet's Giverny as a source of inspiration.

After four years of intensive work with his partners, Northwood Water Gardens were created, comprising nine spring fed lakes, islands, streams, bridges, waterfalls and introducing thousands of specimen trees and shrubs. Mackenzie describes the gardens as his ever-evolving three dimensional organic painting (see website photographs).

His garden designs have featured in several publications and television programmes. A studio and gallery were built within the gardens, and Mackenzie has progressively established himself as one of Cornwall's prominent painters, exhibiting in several solo and group shows.

His work features in private collections in Europe, Canada and the U.S.A. This is his first solo show in Brighton, where he now mainly lives. Works using mixed media on canvas, are presented in a splendid garden house, set within an enchanting walled garden. Prices range from £65 to £2000. Cards are also available.
