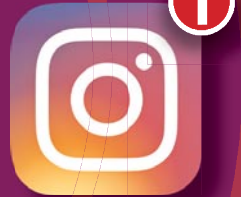

Over four weekends in May, artists open their doors to offer work from over 1,200 artists, exhibiting in more than 180 venues across the city of Brighton, Hove and beyond. The Open Houses are grouped in local trails, each with their own unique character, from the fishermen's houses of Hanover, Regency houses of Brunswick, to the urban warehouse spaces of the North Laine and cottages of the South Downs village of Ditchling.

Visiting Open Houses offers the chance to meet the artists and to buy work directly from them. The hugely diverse range of artwork on show includes original paintings, prints, graffiti arts, ceramics and textiles, as well as photography, sculpture, crafts, jewellery and many other media.

The Artists Open Houses is an inclusive open-to-all event, welcoming participation from all areas of the community, including community groups, marginalized, school and college student artists.

Visiting local artists in their homes and studios is an unmissable part of the Brighton festivals' season. Many Open Houses also offer the opportunity to get involved, providing workshops and events for both adults and children. Entry to the houses is free. With homemade tea and cake on offer too, the Artists Open Houses are a very special weekend treat.

Penelope Kenny, the Artists Open Houses May 2017 Brochure Cover Artist, is an Australian born artist who now lives and works in Brighton. Her work explores the relationship between humans and other animals, especially in connection to transhumanism, evolution, hybrids and biotechnology. Through her hybrid creatures she investigates the potential outcomes of humans trying to control evolution through genetic manipulation and scientific tampering with the species boundaries.

Since completing a BA in Printmaking at the University of Brighton she has exhibited widely, in the UK and internationally. She creates limited edition textiles, fine art screenprints, wallpapers and books using hand-made inks made from pure pigments and metallic glazes.

Mackenzie Bell studied Fine Art at Exeter, Brighton and Central St. Martins. He taught Art in Los Angeles and Sydney and was Head of Art at St. Pauls College in Mid Sussex. In 1997 he left teaching to pursue a passion for painting and landscape garden design. He moved to Cornwall to create a five acre water garden, taking Monet's Giverny as a source of inspiration.

After four years of intensive work with his partners, Northwood Water Gardens were created, comprising nine spring fed lakes, islands, streams, bridges, waterfalls and introducing thousands of specimen trees and shrubs. Mackenzie describes the gardens as his ever-evolving three dimensional organic painting (see website photographs).

His garden designs have featured in several publications and television programmes. A studio and gallery were built within the gardens, and Mackenzie has progressively established himself as one of Cornwall's prominent painters, exhibiting in several solo and group shows.

His work features in private collections in Europe, Canada and the U.S.A. This is his first solo show in Brighton, where he now mainly lives. Works using mixed media on canvas, are presented in a splendid garden house, set within an enchanting walled garden. Prices range from £65 to £2000. Cards are also available.
